Easy Devil's Food Cake (A Hit at the Picnic)

2 cup sugar 2 ½ cup flour

1 cup veg. oil ½ cup powdered cocoa 2 eggs 3 tsp baking soda 1 cup sour milk 1 cup boiling water

(to sour milk, add 2 tbsp vinegar)

Dump sugar, oil, eggs, milk, flour and cocoa into large mixing bowl and mix well. Add baking soda, mix in well. Add 1 cup boiling water, mix in well. Pour into a greased Bundt pan. Bake at 375 degrees for 35-40 minutes.
