A similar format has been confirmed for Sebring, July 17th & 18th, full SCHEDULE to follow.

IMSA will limit the number of personnel to 15 for each car entered at Daytona and Sebring.

Each car will be permitted to have one spotter, based exclusively outside of the facility, for the Daytona race, with that person not going against the personnel limit in the garage.

The restrictions have been put into place as part of IMSA's COVID-19 protocol, which is currently being finalized.

Team and Manufacturer PR representatives will not likely be permitted to attend in-person, with only a limited selection of journalists and photographers set to be given access to the closed-door events at Daytona and Sebring.

Essential personnel from suppliers (like Michelin Tire, MW) will be permitted, although a criteria has yet to be released.

IMSA teams were informed on 5-28-20 that Department of Homeland Security Acting Secretary Chad Wolf met with IMSA leadership on Wednesday, 5-27-20, notifying that motorsports has been included in the DHS order from May 22 "that exempts certain foreign professional athletes who compete in professional sporting events organized by certain leagues, including their essential staff and their dependents, from proclamations barring their entry into the U.S."

Fully, half of IMSA race teams are represented by drivers, mechanics, engineers, manufacturers, and other staff who travel to the US. The update from Acting Secretary Wolf means IMSA (and any other domestic series with multi-national participants) can get back to racing with its full team.
